
ASSESSMENT BASICS Letter Sound Fluency (LSF) Developed at Vanderbilt University



A. Key Implementation Criteria:

- 1. Available for Kindergarten
- 2. Manual includes 5 lists with 26 letters in random order.
- 3. Test is administered to students individually.
- 4. Students have 1 minute to say the sound that corresponds with the 26 letters.
- The score is based on the number of correct letter sounds spoken in 1 minute.

B. Assessment Skills:

1. Monitors student progress in beginning decoding at Kindergarten.

C. Benefits:

- 1. Administering and scoring the test is easy.
- 2. Letter Sound Fluency tracks students' overall progress in decoding over time.
- 3. Students are aware of how their decoding skills are progressing.
