

## PROGRAM BASICS

### PALS Math Grades 2 - 6 Intervention

Developed at Vanderbilt University

#### A. Overview:

The PALS Grades 2 – 6 program covers the comprehensive math curriculum including numeration, number concepts, computation of whole numbers, fractions, and decimals, measurement and geometry, figures/graphs, and word problems.

The specific skills addressed at each grade correspond to the standards most frequently represented at each level of the curriculum.

Activities include COACHING (in which students teach each other math skills) and PRACTICE (a mixed problem-type timed drill that incorporates the type of problem addressed during that day's Coaching, as well as easier problem types).

#### B. Program Details:

2. Schedule - This program starts with a whole class training session and has a 20 week implementation schedule with 30 minute sessions 2 times a week.
